

SOUTH FLORIDA COUNCIL “TOE OF THE BAREFOOT MAILMAN” HIKE

With the intent of promoting increased participation in hiking the historic trails of our council, the Barefoot Mailman Committee offers this opportunity to those younger Boy Scouts and Webelos Scouts who are not eligible to participate in the full Barefoot experience. These Scouts may register to walk the 2nd day of the Barefoot Mailman Trail and receive a patch to for completing “The Toe of the Barefoot”. **Early Registration Fee is \$10.00 Until January 29th, or \$13.00 after January 29th.** Scouts can register the day of the event. All Units and hikers need to check in the day of the hike (7:00 a.m., at Haulover Park).

START LOCATION: Haulover Park, 10800 Collins Ave, Miami Beach, west side of A1A, north of Haulover Inlet, on the north side of the Golf Course, in the south-west corner of the parking area).

ENDING LOCATION: In South Pointe Park (Tentative location: exact location to be announced in January). All hikers will congregate in this location at the end of the hike. Patches will be distributed, refreshments served, and hikers are to be picked up from this location.

This event is open to Boy and Cub Scouts that have shown themselves to be strong hikers, with the ability to complete a hike of a minimum of 15 miles, at a strong pace (+ 3 miles per hour). Units should participate in ‘pre-hikes’ to help them practice their hiking skills, Unit integrity, and ability to stay together as a hiking unit.

Scouts participating in the Big-Toe are to register the morning of the hike. The Scouts will not camp overnight at Haulover Park. They should arrange to arrive for registration at 7:00 a.m. on February 14th and hike with their units until completion.

Each unit having members hiking the ‘Toe’, must have a minimum of one adult hiking, who will be responsible for the hikers. In addition, each unit must have a designated support vehicle (either as part of the unit, or another unit that is participating in the hike). Packs can hike with a Troop and, with mutual understanding, combine leadership to cover the hikers.

The Rules for the ‘Big Toe’ Hikers as the regular Barefoot Hikes (i.e., They must be in **Class-A uniform**, they should be self-sufficient for the hike [with the exception of water, only use or eat what they carry themselves], they must stay with their unit/section, no purchase of food or other items along the way, [see Rules for Barefoot Mailman Hike). Please review and explain these rules to ALL your hikers and support personnel.
